



JUMPSTART DUAL CREDIT PROGRAM

Frequently Asked Questions:

ARE FEES REFUNDABLE?

Once the semester begins, fees are nonrefundable.

HOW ABOUT COURSE TEXTBOOKS?

Textbooks will be selected by CSN in accordance with the state-approved adopted textbook list.

HOW CAN I GET A COPY OF MY COLLEGE GRADES?

Unofficial transcripts may be obtained, at no charge, on-line if the student attended CSN the previous semester. Official transcripts may also be obtained on-line, or in person for a fee of \$2.00 by contacting the office of the Registrar.

IS A PLACEMENT TEST REQUIRED OF ALL COURSES?

No. Diagnostics and assessments appropriate for placement in the Math and English courses are required FREE of charge to the student. ACT/SAT scores may be used in lieu of placement tests. Contact the Testing Center for more information.

HOW MANY CLASSES CAN I TAKE PER SEMESTER?

Students can enroll in a maximum of two classes per semester (regardless of the number of credits).

CAN STUDENTS NOT ENROLLED IN THE CLASS ATTEND CLASS?

No. Only students enrolled and registered with the Jumpstart Program are allowed in the classroom.

ARE THE CREDITS EARNED POSTED ON MY COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT?

Yes! All Jumpstart classes are taught to meet the rigor and standards of current college courses and all classes are designed to meet the college's academic requirements. Each credit earned will be posted on the student's college transcript.

WILL ALL MY CREDITS TRANSFER TO ANOTHER COLLEGE?

While all dual enrollment courses grant credits, not all are applicable toward a university degree. For example, remedial courses such as Math 96 or English 98 are not credits applicable toward a degree, but are posted on the transcript. It is important to recognize, however, that the advantages received by the experience obtained in a dual enrollment class extend beyond transferability.
