- Once this contract is completed and beginning **May 27, 2009**, SFS will notify the CSN Bookstore of my eligibility for required course materials with an electronic book voucher.
- I will pay any outstanding balance owed for summer 2009 to the College of Southern Nevada by **July 31, 2009**.

2009 CSN Summer Fact Sheet

You have been identified by Student Financial Services (SFS) as potentially eligible for a Federal Pell Grant for summer 2009 enrollment. Here is what you should do and what you can expect:

To Do:

1. Review the email sent by Student Financial Services to your CSN email address.
2. Enroll for an appropriate number of summer classes at the College of Southern Nevada. Attend the classes to their completion.
3. Visit the CSN Cashier with a 'good faith' payment and complete your *2009 CSN Summer Delayed Payment Contract* before the May 21, 2009 deadline.
4. After May 27th, visit the CSN Bookstore to purchase your required course materials.
5. Talk to the CSN Counseling Department if you are considering withdrawing from your classes, because withdrawing may invalidate the agreement.
6. Pay any outstanding balance owed CSN after July 20th and before July 31st.

What to Expect:

- A. The CSN Cashier will confirm your eligibility for the *2009 CSN Summer Delayed Payment Contract*, accept your good faith payment, and notify SFS and Registrar that the contract is in effect.
- B. SFS will notify the CSN Bookstore that you qualify for a summer semester book voucher. The amount of the voucher will correspond to your enrollment level.
- C. As long as the contract is in effect, the CSN Registrar will prevent the administrative disenrollment/purge of your classes. Classes may be canceled by the college due to underenrollment; please continually monitor your registration online.
- D. SFS will work with the federal government to secure your Pell Grant eligibility and release the payment during the week of July 13, 2009.
