I have been identified by Student Financial Services as potentially eligible for a 2010 summer Federal Pell Grant. By checking each box below, I understand:

- I must **enroll and attend** CSN summer classes. The anticipated Federal Pell Grant may change if my enrollment plans change, is *not guaranteed*, and is subject to all applicable financial aid rules and regulations.

- If I withdraw completely from summer classes I will invalidate this payment extension and be required to make immediate tuition and registration fee payment.
- If eligible, my Federal Pell Grant will apply to my student balance around **July 9, 2010**.
- If ineligible for the Federal Pell Grant, then payment in full is expected at time of notification and this contract no longer keeps me from being subject to the CSN administrative drop.
- I must complete this contract and make a good faith payment of \$50 by **May 21, 2010** at the CSN Cashier's Office to hold my classes. Otherwise, I will be subject to administrative drop.
- All contracts completed with the 'good faith payment' will be considered for a CSN Book Voucher. If selected I will be notified by email around **May 28, 2010**.
- I will pay any remaining balance for Summer 2010 to the College of Southern Nevada by **July 30, 2010**.

2010 CSN Summer Fact Sheet

You have been identified by Student Financial Services (SFS) as potentially eligible for a Federal Pell Grant for summer 2010 enrollment. Here is what you should do and what you can expect:

To Do:

1. Review the email sent by Student Financial Services to your CSN email address.
2. Enroll for an appropriate number of summer classes at the College of Southern Nevada. Attend the classes to their completion.
3. Visit the CSN Cashier with a 'good faith' payment and complete your *2010 CSN Summer Delayed Payment Contract* by the **May 21, 2010 deadline**.
4. If notified of a CSN Book Voucher Award by email, and after June 2nd, visit the CSN Bookstore to purchase your required course materials.
5. Talk to Student Financial Services if you are considering withdrawing from your classes, because withdrawing may invalidate the agreement and Pell Grant eligibility.
6. Pay any outstanding charges owed CSN after July 11th and by July 30th.

What to Expect:

- A. The CSN Cashier will collect your signed *2010 CSN Summer Delayed Payment Contract*, accept your good faith payment, and notify SFS and Registrar that the contract is in effect.
- B. SFS will award CSN Book Vouchers to some of the students submitting a *2010 CSN Summer Delayed Payment Contract* by the May 21st deadline. Book Voucher recipients will be notified by email (check that the Registrar has your correct email address).
- C. Provided you submit your contract and payment by May 21st, the CSN Registrar will prevent the administrative drop of your classes. Classes may be canceled by the college due to under-enrollment; please continually monitor your registration online.
- D. SFS will work with the federal government to secure your summer award. Pell Grant payments begin around July 9th, and any excess funds will begin being refunded around July 19th.
- E. If ineligible for the Federal Pell Grant, then payment in full is expected at time of notification and this contract no longer keeps me from being subject to the CSN administrative drop.
