What is WUE?

WUE is the Western Undergraduate Exchange, a program of the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE). Through WUE, students in the western states may enroll in many two-year and four-year college programs at a reduced tuition level: 150 percent of the institution's regular resident tuition. WUE tuition is considerably less than nonresident tuition.

Who is Eligible?

Only newly admitted students are eligible to apply. The WUE application process must be completed before the student is in attendance at CCSN. Once the student has been admitted and enrolled at CCSN without WUE status, he/she is no longer eligible for the WUE program.
