

**GENERAL DEGREE REQUIREMENTS - ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE (AAS)**

Coursework must total at least 60 credits. The AAS degree includes between 60-72 total credit hours including between 25-29 credit hours in general education. In no case, may one course be used to meet more than one requirement. Only courses numbered 100 or above may be used.

The Associate of Applied Science degree provides employment related and career enhancing skills necessary to succeed in a chosen occupational or technical field of study. Although the AAS degree is not designed to transfer to a four-year program, some of the courses will transfer to four-year colleges and universities.
