

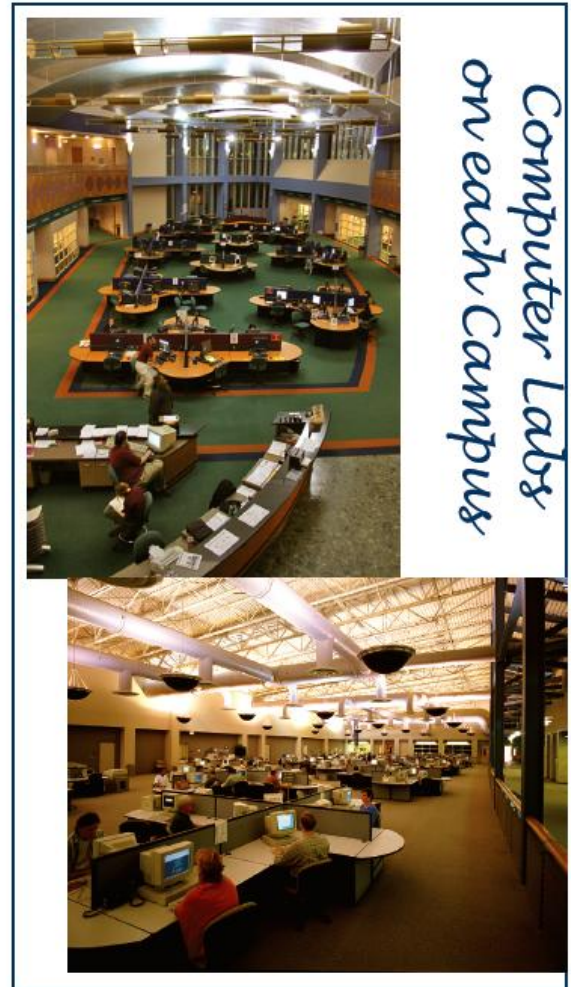
Program Objectives
