Civilian students are welcome and encouraged to complete course work at the Nellis AFB Campus. However, due to the nature of the agreement between CSN and the Air Force and more importantly due to security concerns, there are restrictions that govern how civilian students register and attend courses on the military installation. Take note of the regulations listed below:

- Please keep in mind that your access to the base is a privilege and not a right. Security Forces can revoke this privilege at any time; you are required to follow any instructions and/or warnings they may give you.
- By requesting a Nellis AFB Visitor Pass, you are giving your consent to the Air Force to complete a background check. Should your access be denied, you will not be permitted to attend classes on Nellis AFB.
- Your access on base is limited to the Force Support Squadron building (aka Building 20).
- The speed limit on base is 25 mph unless otherwise stated.
- Talking on cellular devices is prohibited while driving – the only exception is if you use a hands-free device.
- You and your car are subject to search at any time.
- No guests are allowed on base with you.
- You are solely responsible for towing fees, if they should occur.
- I understand that this base access is only for the days and times of my class(es) and I will be authorized admittance only for class attendance at building 20 or other designated official class locations.
- I will not be permitted to wander around the base or be seen in any restricted area.
- I will keep my pass in my possession and will not authorize others to use or borrow it.
- **PICK UP BASE PASS:** 48 hours after submitting your request for base access, call the Nellis AFB Visitor Center at 702-652-3216 to see if access has been granted. *******You should tell them you are a student with The College of Southern Nevada.** If a pass has been granted you may proceed to the visitor center to obtain a temporary pass allowing you access to the base. Proceed to building 20 and come to the CSN office (3rd floor, Room 318) to register for your class and obtain your long-term pass. **Please Note: LONG-TERM PASSES ARE ISSUED MONDAY, TUESDAY, and THURSDAY 8:00AM-4:00PM and WEDNESDAY 8:00AM-3:30PM.******
