An Associate of Applied Science Degree is also available with areas of emphasis in: Correctional, Hotel/Industry Security, Juvenile Justice, Law Enforcement, Law Enforcement Training Academy. 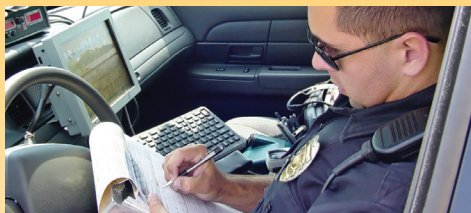


Convenience and Flexibility

CSN Police Academy

The Southern Desert Police Academy is offered to non-affiliated students. Student must be U.S. citizens, a minimum of 21 years of age, pass a written examination, medical examination, physical agility test, and a background investigation before they can be admitted into this 22 week program. Those students that pass the academy will receive 33 criminal justice credits and a Nevada POST certificate as a Category 1 Peace Officer.
