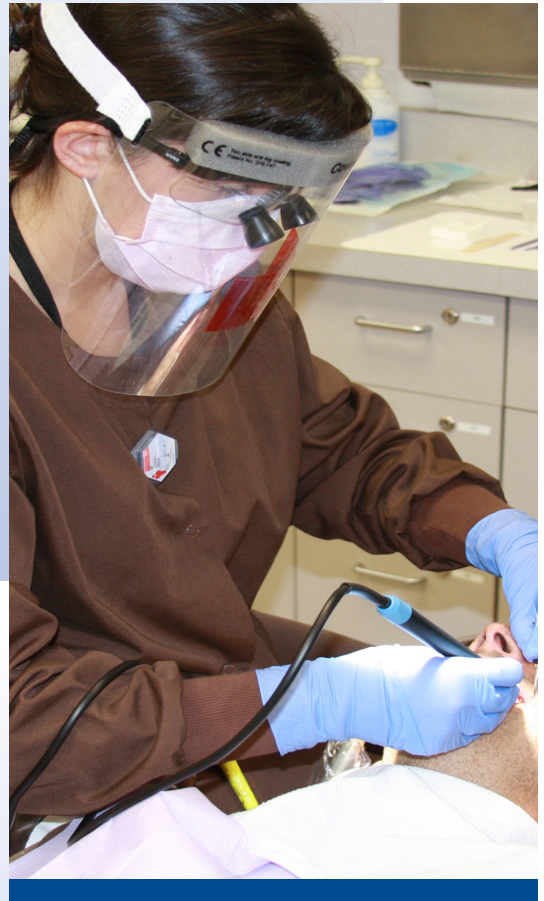

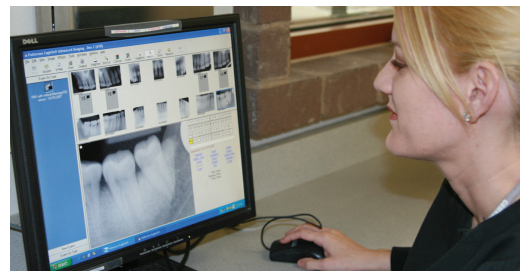

Thank you for your interest in the Dental Hygiene Program. The Associate of Science Degree Program is designed to train students for entry-level employment and is limited-entry. The curriculum consists of 88 credit-hours over a two-year period. Prospective students must meet the program prerequisites and have good hand/eye coordination and manual dexterity to allow accurate use of dental instruments in the mouth during direct patient care. Graduates must complete the written National Board Dental Hygiene Examination as well as a clinical examination conducted by a state or regional board in order to become licensed to practice.

The Bachelor of Science Degree Completion Program is completely on-line and available to students with an active dental hygiene license and a degree from an accredited dental hygiene program. Students are expected to enroll in 2-6 credit hours per semester. The program offers an Education Track and a Public Health Track and is designed for the pursuit of this degree on a part-time or full-time basis. Graduates will be qualified for an array of career opportunities in public health, administration, teaching, research, management and related fields.

Upon completion of the Dental Hygiene Program you will receive an Associate of Science Degree with a Bachelor of Science Degree available.
