**T**hank you for your interest in the Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program. This program is a six-semester program that prepares students for careers in Cardiac/Vascular or General/Vascular Ultrasound. The curriculum is designed to train students in the use of ultrasound for the imaging of soft tissue and vascular systems in the abdomen and pelvis area as well as the heart. With the completion of coursework the student is eligible to take the examination for certification as a Registered Diagnostic Medical Sonographer and/or a Registered Cardiac Sonographer. Career opportunities for diagnostic medical sonographers are expected to grow faster than the average for most occupations as the population grows and ages, increasing the demand for diagnostic imaging and therapeutic technology.
