The Emergency Management Administration Program helps prepare students for a career in the area of emergency management and homeland security. Students learn skills to manage fire department operations, hazardous materials incidents, tactics,

strategy, and safety of firefighting activities, and customer service in the public sector.

The student will be prepared for positions

such as Emergency Manager, Emergency Management Planner, Emergency Operations Coordinator, Environmental Compliance Planner, and Emergency Management Specialist, working in state, local, federal, and international governments, business and industry, military installations, and health care facilities. This career field overlaps into both the criminal justice and fire science areas.

Upon completion of the Emergency Management Program you will receive an Associate of Arts Degree.
