**T**hank you for your interest in the Phlebotomy Program. Phlebotomists usually work under the direction of a lead phlebotomist or medical technologist, where they may collect blood specimens, check samples and assume responsibility for patients' comfort and safety. They perform venipuncture, skin punctures, blood culture collection and other laboratory tests and may also have responsibility for specimen handling and processing. A Certificate of Completion in Phlebotomy consists of three courses totaling five total credit hours. Courses include lecture, laboratory and a clinical practicum of 120 hours at a clinical site. Upon successful completion of the Phlebotomy program, students are qualified to take a national certification examination and qualify for Nevada licensure. There is the potential for careers in reference and hospital laboratories. At CSN you will find small class sizes designed for one-on-one attention helping to ensure the successful completion of this program. Please read through this brochure to help you plan your next step in this program.
