**SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Students must currently be enrolled in a degree seeking program of study and complete the Community College of Southern Nevada Scholarship Application to be considered for CCSN scholarships.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION:

Application Priority filing date: January 16 , 2007 – May 1, 2007.

Final Application deadline: October 30, 2007

Continuing CCSN Students: Students must have completed a minimum of 12 credits at CCSN with at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA to be considered.

Transfer Students: Students must have completed a minimum of 12 transferable credits from a Nevada System of Higher Education (NSHE) institution with a 2.0 cumulative transfer GPA to be considered.

Incoming high school students: An official copy of your high school transcript indicating a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.0 or above must be included with your CCSN Scholarship Application in order to be considered for scholarships. **Scholarship Applications submitted without an official transcript will automatically be considered ineligible.**

New or Returning Students: CCSN has limited scholarship opportunities for students who have never attended college before and students returning who have been out of school for 5 or more years.

Ethnicity: Some scholarships are awarded based on a student's ethnic background. The Office of the Registrar has record of students declared ethnic background based on their admissions form. Student Financial Services will use this information as needed during scholarship selection.

Need or Non-Need based: Scholarships are designated as either Need or Non-Need Based. Student Financial Services determines financial need according to the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). The FAFSA can be found online at www.fafsa.ed.gov as early as January 1, of every year. All students are highly encouraged to apply. **The FAFSA should be completed a minimum of 2 weeks prior to turning in your completed scholarship application. If you decide not to complete the FAFSA, you will automatically be considered a Non-Need student and will only be considered for Non-Need based scholarships.**

Award Notification: Students selected for a scholarship(s) will be notified by regular mail. It is the student's responsibility to update any address changes with The Office of the Registrar. Award letters will be sent no earlier than August 2007 for the Fall 2007/ Spring 2008 semesters. Selections occur throughout the year, with the majority of scholarships awarded in August for the upcoming fall semester. Because the scholarship application is valid for the entire 2007-2008 school year, students will not receive a denial letter after scholarship selections are determined at any point during the year.
