

Cut-Off Scores for Placement Purposes

Placement via the ACCUPLACER Placement Test

Can only be taken every 4 months! - Scores cannot be older than 1 year!

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Whenever you take the ACCUPLACER Placement Test, you are **ALWAYS FIRST** given the Elementary Algebra portion. Depending on your answers to the questions, you may then also have to take the Arithmetic or the College-Level Mathematics portions. Scores are based on a 120-point scale.

Placement Code: **Math 091**

If students' scores are less than **50/120 on the Arithmetic Test**, they are placed into Math 116, Math 115, Math 100, or Math 091.

Placement Code: **Math 093**

If students' scores are greater than or equal to **50/120 on the Arithmetic Test** and less than **50/120 on the Elementary Algebra Test**, they are placed into Math 116, Math 115B, Math 100B, Math 093, or Math 091.

Placement Code: **Math 095**

If students' scores are greater than or equal to **50/120 on the Elementary Algebra Test** and less than **85/120 on the Elementary Algebra Test**, they are placed into Math 116, Math 115B, Math 100B, Math 095, Math 093, or Math 091.

Placement Code: **Math 096**

If students' scores are greater than or equal to **85/120 on the Elementary Algebra Test** and less than **65/120 on the College-Level Test**, they are placed into Math 116, Math 115B, Math 111B, Math 100B, Math 97 (5 credit hour combination of Math 095 & Math 096), Math 096, or below.

Placement Code: **Math 126**

If students' scores are greater than or equal to **65/120 on the College-Level Test** and less than **90/120 on the College-Level Test**, they are placed into Math 126 or below.

Placement Code: **Math 127**

If students' scores are greater than or equal to **90/120 on the College-Level Test** and less than **110/120 on the College-Level Test**, they are placed into Stat 152, Math 132, Math 128 (5 credit hour combination of Math 126 & Math 127), Math 127, or below.

Placement Code: **Math 181**

If students' scores are greater than or equal to **110/120 on the College-Level Test**, they are placed into Math 181 or below.

Placement via the Math Diagnostic Tests for Certain Courses
Can only be taken every 4 months! - Scores cannot be older than 1 year!

Any student who is not willing to accept an initial placement level through the Accuplacer Test (Math 093 to Math 096) may attempt to raise the placement level by taking the appropriate Math Diagnostic Test.

The passing score for a Diagnostic Test is 70% with the exception of the courses listed below.

- A student wishing to place into Math 097 must pass the Diagnostic Test for Math 95/97 with 80%.

If the student does not pass a Diagnostic Tests, he/she MUST adhere to the Accuplacer placement or the last Diagnostic Test passed successfully.

Placement via CLEP Scores
Scores cannot be older than 2 years!

- College Mathematics CLEP Score of 50 or above - Give credit for Math 120.
- College Algebra CLEP Score of 50 or above - Give credit for Math 124.
- College Algebra-Trigonometry CLEP Score of 50 or above - Give credit for Math 126.
- Precalculus CLEP Score of 50 or above - Give credit for Math 126.
- Calculus CLEP Score of 50 or above - Give credit for Math 181.

Placement via AP Scores
Scores cannot be older than 2 years!

Students with AP Calculus AB or BC scores of 4 or above will get credit for Math 181, Calculus I.
Students with AP Statistics scores of 4 or above will get credit for Stat 152 - Introduction to Statistics.

Placement via ACT or SAT Scores
Scores cannot be older than 2 years!
