Each camper will get 100's of swings through various hitting drills.

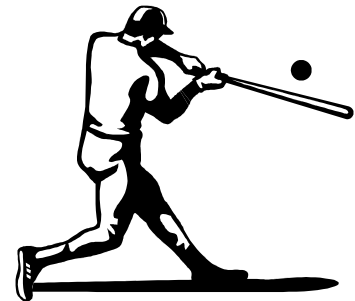
Catchers need to bring their own equipment.

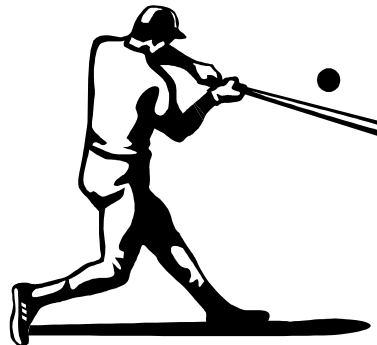
