The Coyote baseball camp is designed to give your child the best evaluation possible. There will be group and one-on-one instruction daily. The first day will include 60 yard times, throwing from positions, radar times on pitchers, pop times for catchers and live batting practice in front of SNBC instructors. The second day will include a live scrimmage to provide your son the opportunity to compete against other campers in front of the SNBC staff. **The camp will be located at Morse Stadium. Morse Stadium is at the CSN Henderson campus.**

Each camper will get 100's of swings through various hitting drills.

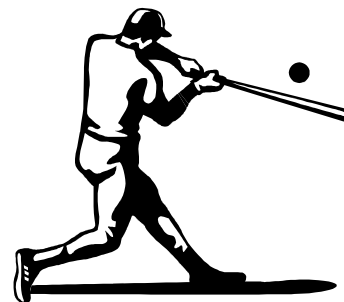
Catchers need to bring their own equipment.

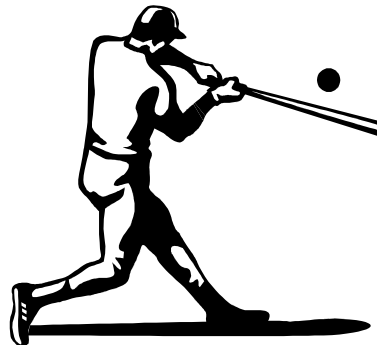
