  graduation date and/or completion. If in a language other than English, the diploma or transcript must be evaluated through a NACES member
  organization (<a href="https://www.naces.org/members">https://www.naces.org/members</a>)
- Completion of ENG 100, 101, 110, or 113, with a "C" or better

Medical Assisting is NOT a Limited Entry program, however a Medical Assisting application is required.
