## Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene Limited Entry Selection Criteria

I. Cumulative <u>Prerequisite</u> GPA (for the following courses): BIOL 189, BIOL 223, BIOL 224, CHEM 121, CLS 261, CLS 262, DH 100, DH 102, BIOL 121, ENG 101, ENG 102, and COM 101:

IV. TEAS PRE-ADMISSION EXAM (ATI): The <u>TEAS Information and Registration Form</u> are available online at: <a href="https://www.csn.edu/csn-teas">https://www.csn.edu/csn-teas</a>. Minimum cut-off scores <u>must be met in EACH testing area</u> to apply.

<u>Please Note:</u> Points will be awarded for applicants who exceed program benchmarks in **Reading and English ONLY**. Although the <u>minimum cut-off scores in Math and Science must be met to apply</u>, no additional points will be rewarded for those testing areas.

Exam retake attempts <u>MUST</u> be complete prior to February 1st application deadline to be considered for admissions to the program. Students who have taken the TEAS from another state and/or institution must have their scores officially transferred to CSN before their specified application deadline date. A maximum of six (6) attempts lifetime for the TEAS is permitted with no wait time between attempts. Each test is considered a combined complete entity. There will be NO combination of scores from separate tests. TEAS exam results are valid for five (5) years. The application deadline date is used as the reference point for time frames.
