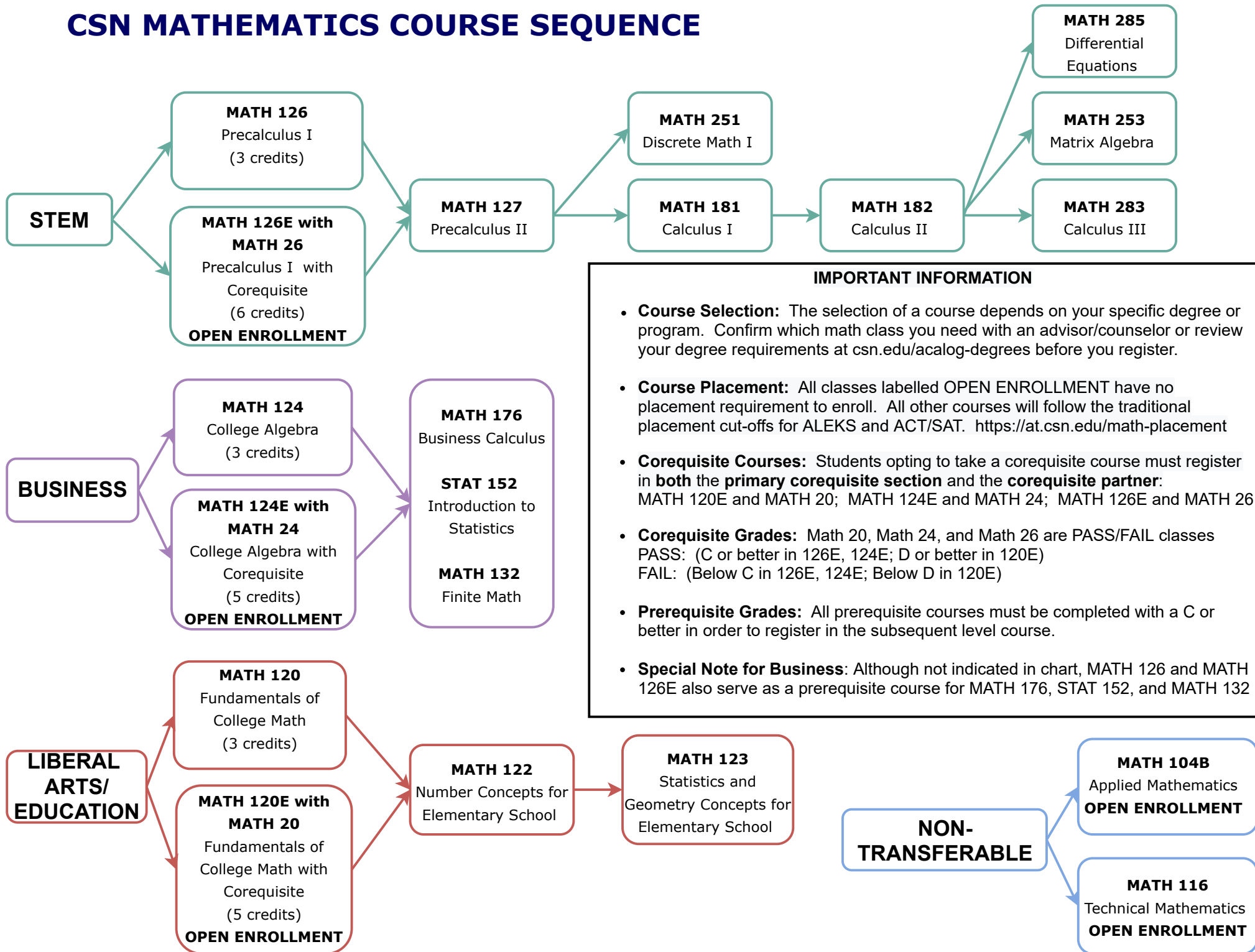


CSN MATHEMATICS COURSE SEQUENCE



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **Course Selection:** The selection of a course depends on your specific degree or program. Confirm which math class you need with an advisor/counselor or review your degree requirements at csn.edu/acalog-degrees before you register.
- **Course Placement:** All classes labelled OPEN ENROLLMENT have no placement requirement to enroll. All other courses will follow the traditional placement cut-offs for ALEKS and ACT/SAT. <https://at.csn.edu/math-placement>
- **Corequisite Courses:** Students opting to take a corequisite course must register in **both** the **primary corequisite section** and the **corequisite partner**: MATH 120E and MATH 20; MATH 124E and MATH 24; MATH 126E and MATH 26
- **Corequisite Grades:** Math 20, Math 24, and Math 26 are PASS/FAIL classes
PASS: (C or better in 126E, 124E; D or better in 120E)
FAIL: (Below C in 126E, 124E; Below D in 120E)
- **Prerequisite Grades:** All prerequisite courses must be completed with a C or better in order to register in the subsequent level course.
- **Special Note for Business:** Although not indicated in chart, MATH 126 and MATH 126E also serve as a prerequisite course for MATH 176, STAT 152, and MATH 132
