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

### **Program Description**

The program includes both classroom instruction and clinical practice in adult (including gerontological) health nursing, family health nursing, and mental health concepts.

Once you have completed the required courses, you will be awarded a Certificate of Achievement, and will then be eligible to apply for state licensure by examination. If you desire career mobility, you may elect to apply for advanced placement for LPN's in the Associate Degree (RN) Program.

### Application Deadline

November  $1^{\text{st}}$ , student will submit application to the PN Program Director.

#### **Accepted Students**

Students accepted into the program will be required to show proof of CPR certification, health insurance, and immunization against Hepatitis B, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Varicella, Tetanus, and Diphtheria. In addition, proof of a negative two-step TB skin test and a negative urine drug screen will be required. A physical examination must also be completed. In addition, an official background check is also required. This documentation is due at the mandatory advising session held one week before classes begin each semester.
