### **Introduction of Three Year Plan**

### **Working Program Outcomes**

### **Direct Measure of Student Learning**

Success will be based upon performance on a comprehensive exit exam by graduated associate of business students. The exit exam will cover business, management and accounting principles. Our goal is 60% of students will score a 70% or higher on the exam.

### **Indirect Measure of Student Learning**

An exit survey will be given to all graduates to measure program satisfaction and transfer intent to a four year institution. Our goal is that 70% of respondents, will rate their program satisfaction as good or better and that 50% are intending to transfer to a four year institution.

An employer survey will be disseminated meant to capture employer satisfaction with CSN Business Management students. Our goal is that 70% of respondents will rate the level of competency and preparedness of the CSN business program students above average.
