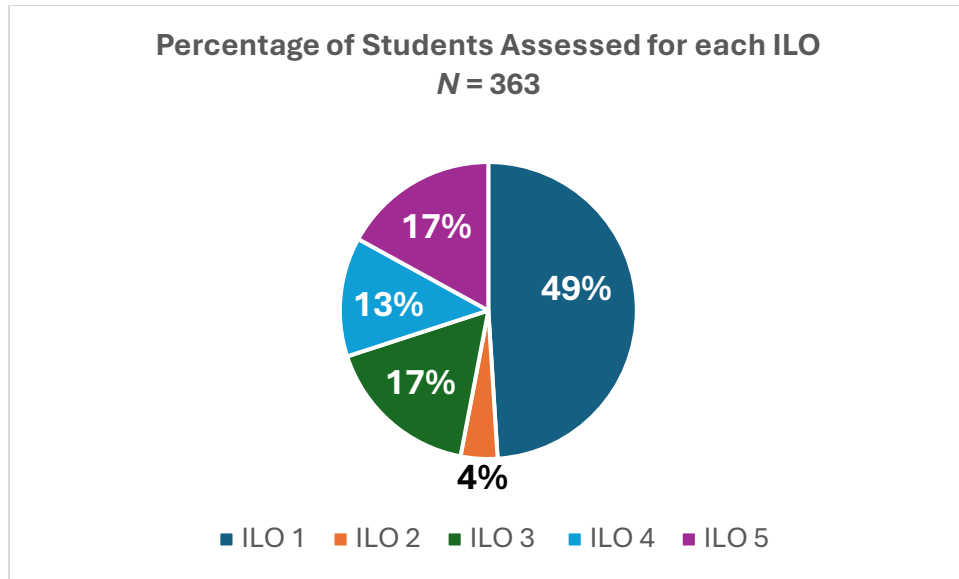
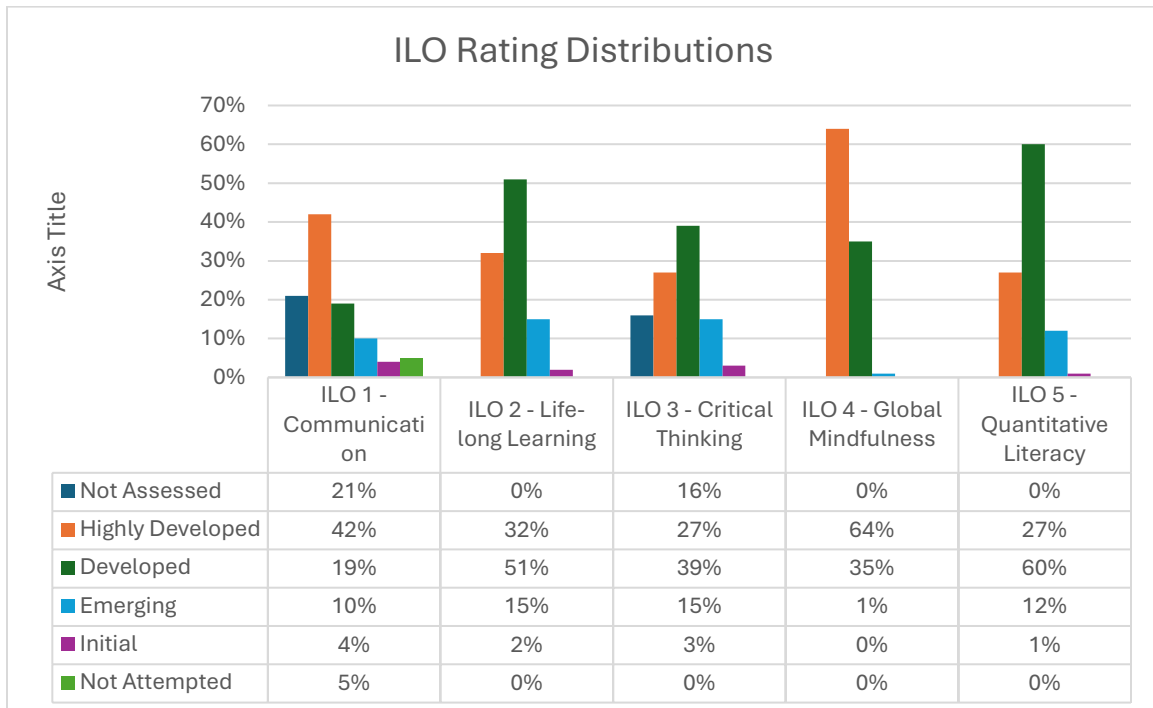


CSN Institutional Learning Outcome Assessment Pilot Project

There were 363 students assessed in the ILO project. Below shows the proportion of assessment for each ILO.



The following chart shows the percentage of students that achieved each rating level within the ILO rubrics.



CSN collected data on five (5) new institutional learning outcomes in Spring 2024. The Office of Institutional Assessment set a goal to see if 75% of students assessed could demonstrate the

learning outcome to a minimum level of emerging or higher and that at least 50% of students could demonstrate a level of developed or higher. The following narrative analysis needs to be interpreted by the Faculty Senate Assessment Committee to determine actions for improvement as well as if and how the project will be scaled up for Fall 2024.

Goal 1: 75% of students at emerging or higher

ILO1 – 71% of students achieved emerging or higher. This measure did not make the benchmark.

ILO2 – 98% of students achieved emerging or higher.

ILO3 – 81% of students achieved emerging or higher. This measure did not make the benchmark.

ILO4 – 100% of students achieved emerging or higher.

ILO5 – 99% of students achieved emerging or higher.

Goal 2: 50% of students at developed or higher.

ILO1 – 61% of students achieved emerging or higher. This measure did not make the benchmark.

ILO2 – 83% of students achieved emerging or higher.

ILO3 – 66% of students achieved emerging or higher. This measure did not make the benchmark.

ILO4 – 88% of students achieved emerging or higher.

ILO5 – 87% of students achieved emerging or higher.
