Civilian students are welcome and encouraged to complete course work at the Nellis AFB Campus. However, due to the nature of the agreement between CSN and the Air Force and more importantly due to security concerns, there are restrictions that govern how civilian students register and attend courses on the military installation. Take note of the regulations listed below:

- Access to the base is a privilege, not a right. Security Forces may revoke this privilege at any time. I am required to follow any instructions and/or warnings they may give me.
- By requesting a Nellis AFB Visitor Pass, I am giving my consent to the Air Force to complete a background check. Should my access be denied, I will not be permitted to attend classes on Nellis AFB.
- My access on base is limited to the Force Support Squadron building (Building 20).
- The speed limit on base is 25 mph unless otherwise stated.
- Talking on cellular devices is prohibited while driving – the only exception is if you use a hands-free device.
- My car and I are subject to search at any time.
- No guests are allowed on base with me.
- I am solely responsible for towing fees, if they should occur.
- I understand that this base access is only for the days and times of my class(es) and I will be authorized admittance only for class attendance at building 20 or other designated official class locations.
- I will not be permitted to wander around the base or be seen in any restricted area.
- I will keep my pass in my possession and will not authorize others to use or borrow it.

PICK UP BASE PASS: 5 business days after submitting your request for base access, call the CSN Nellis office at 702-651-4155 to verify access has been granted. If a pass has been granted, proceed to the visitor's center during business hours (8:00 am – 5:00 pm) no earlier than two days prior to classes starting to obtain your pass allowing you access to the base. Bring a copy of your driver's license, proof of insurance, and car registration.
