For Spatial and Dexterity testing the student is allowed <u>only one retest</u> per five-year period. Tests will expire after five (5) years (based on testing date).

Spatial Perception (SPAT) 3rd attempt. If a student is unable to score 60 or higher within 2 attempts in the 5 year period, the student must acquire an <u>SPAT 3rd attempt Exception</u> <u>Memo</u> from the DH Program Director to be eligible to apply. Please contact the Dental Hygiene department office at702-651-5577 to set up an appointment. <u>Applicants with an SPAT 3rd attempt Exception Memo, will receive zero points for SPAT and will be placed in the 2nd pile for consideration.)</u>

^{*}All Science (BIOL, CHEM) and DH core (DH, CLS) classes must be **no more than 7 years old** by the application deadline date.

IV. TEAS PRE-ADMISSION EXAM (ATI): The <u>TEAS Information and Registration</u> Form are available online at: https://www.csn.edu/csn-teas.

Minimum cut-off scores <u>must be met in EACH testing area</u> to apply.

<u>Please Note:</u> Points will be awarded for applicants who exceed program benchmarks in **Reading and English ONLY**. Although the <u>minimum cut-off scores in Math and Science must be met to apply</u>, no additional points will be rewarded for those testing areas.

Exam retake attempts <u>MUST</u> be complete prior to February 1st application deadline to be considered for admissions to the program. Students who have taken the TEAS from another state and/or institution must have their scores officially transferred to CSN before their specified application deadline date. A maximum of six (6) attempts lifetime for the TEAS is permitted with no wait time between attempts. Each test is considered a combined complete entity. There will be NO combination of scores from separate tests. TEAS exam results are valid for five (5) years. The application deadline date is used as the reference point for time frames.
