



BibliU Quick Reference Guide:

Accessing BibliU & eBooks:

- Log into Canvas
 - Click on either the BibliU logo on the left hand side or click on BibliU from within any course shell



- For faculty wishing to deep embed their book rather than directing students to their BibliU Library in general faculty will want to:
 - Go into any module
 - Click on the top right plus sign to add an item
 - Use the drop down to add an external tool
 - Select BibliU



Accessing Courseware (Coded):

- Once they have accessed BibliU have the student select the Courseware that you are wanting them to use:



- Every student has a unique code and only needs to be used one time when initially accessing the courseware. Following initial access the code will be stored and will not need to be used again.

- Have your students copy the code so they can use it on the publisher site (once the student clicks 'publisher's site' or 'Copy code', BibliU will automatically open a second tab for you that takes you straight onto the publisher's website, or will provide instructions to go back to your LMS).
- Finally, please click on the last hyperlink, at the bottom of the page, in order to view instructions on how the code is redeemed.
- Follow the instructions to activate the Courseware product
- **For Pearson, please note that students will navigate back to Canvas to enter codes into the link provided by you, the professor, to Pearson MyLabs.

Accessing Courseware (LTI):

BibliU is simply removing any paywalls associated with using these products. You will not see anything in BibliU associated with these course materials.
