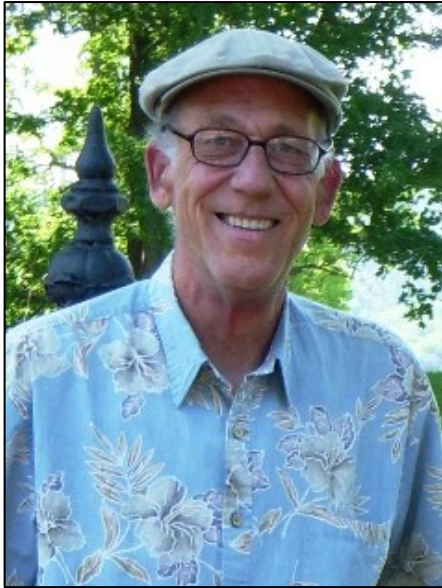


In Fond Memory of Randy Harwood

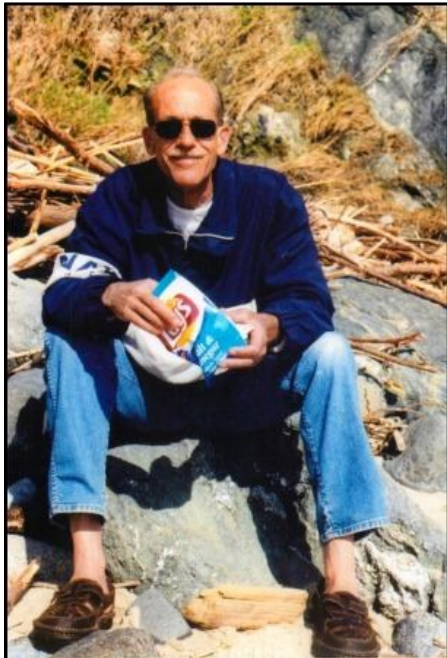


Figure 3 Randy Enjoying a Snack on a Rocky Beach

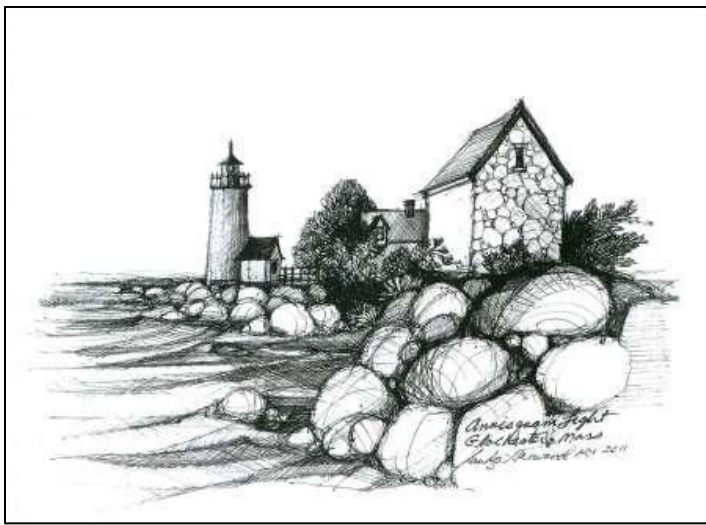


Figure 5 Annisquam Lighthouse, Gloucester, Mass. ketch by Randy Harwood

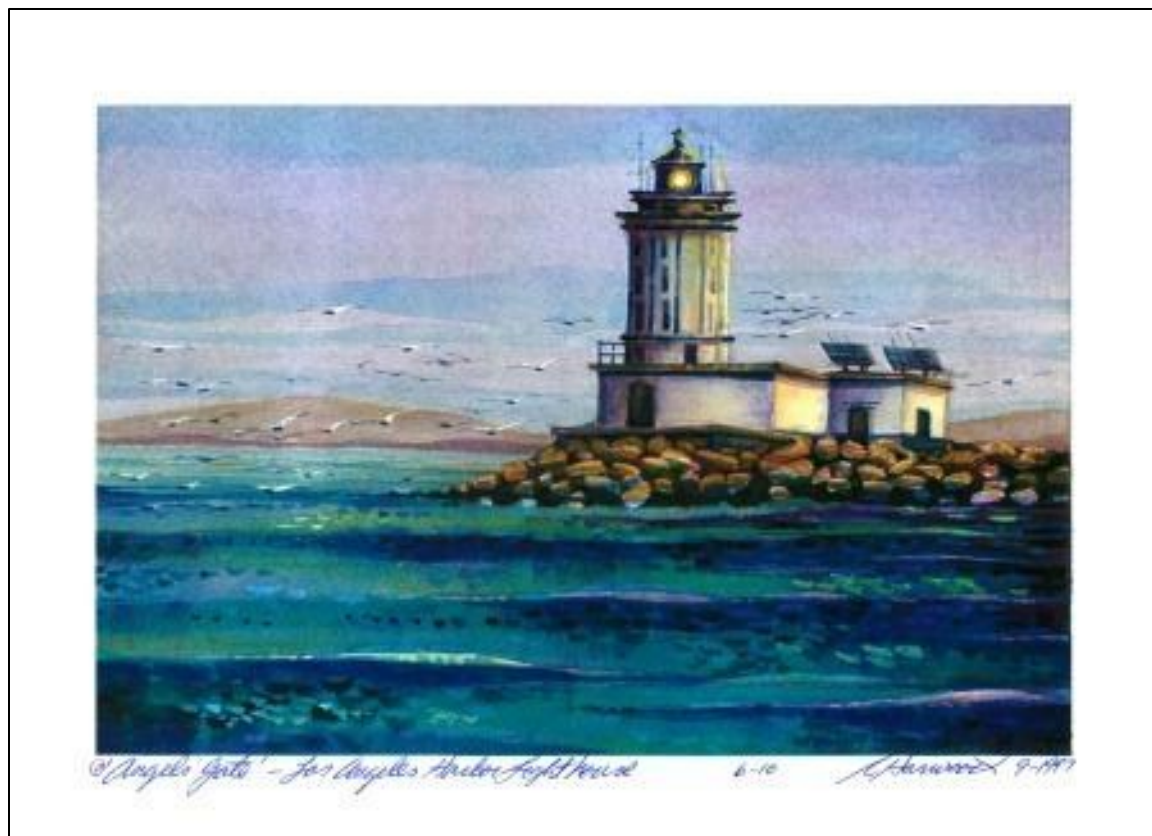


Figure 8 Angels Gate Lighthouse, San Pedro, Calif. watercolor by Randy Harwood.
