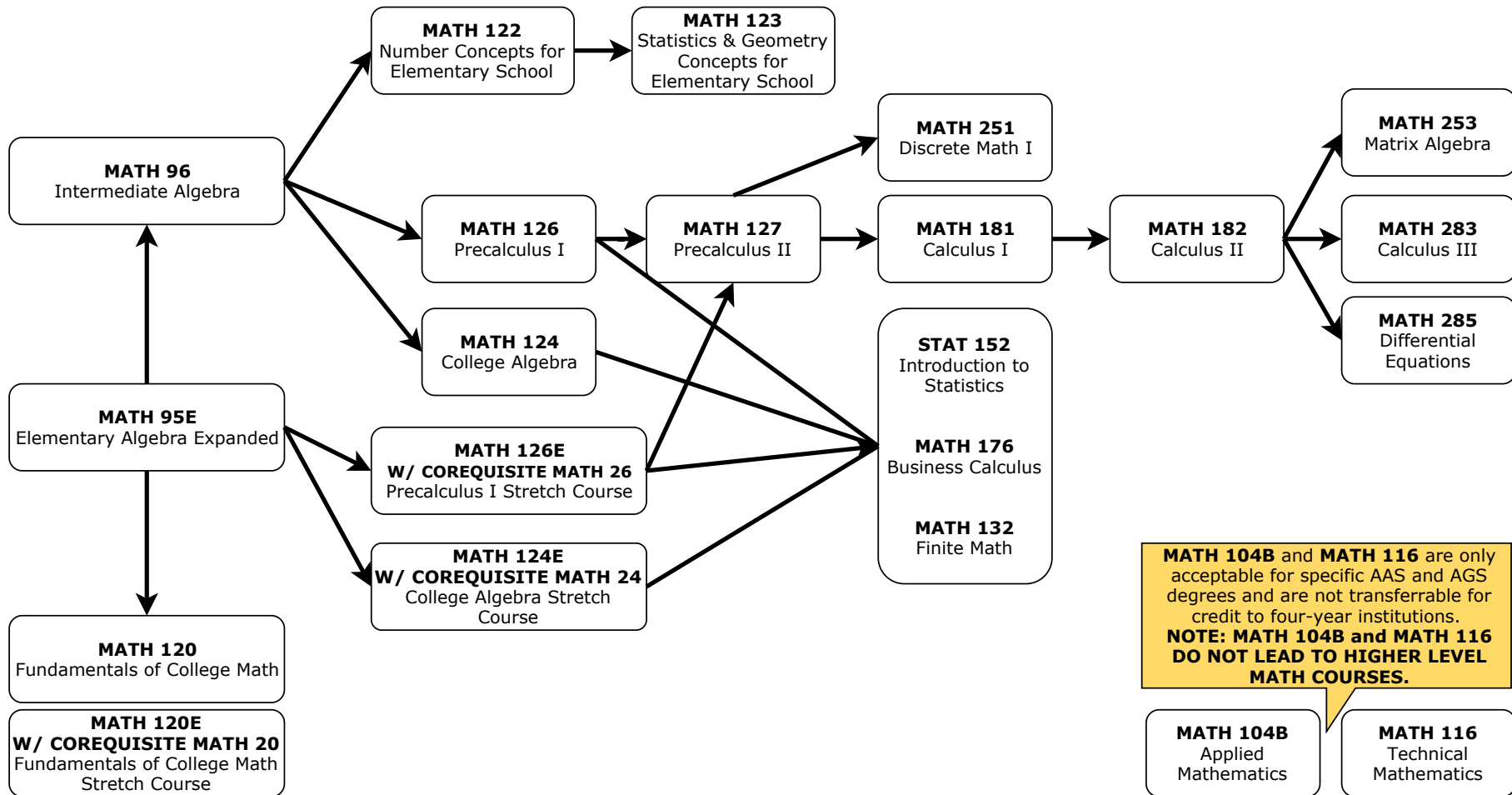


CSN MATHEMATICS COURSE SEQUENCE



MATH 104B and **MATH 116** are only acceptable for specific AAS and AGS degrees and are not transferrable for credit to four-year institutions.
NOTE: MATH 104B and MATH 116 DO NOT LEAD TO HIGHER LEVEL MATH COURSES.

Important Information

- COURSE SELECTION:** The selection of a course depends on your specific degree or program. Confirm which math class you need with an advisor/counselor or review your degree requirements at csn.edu/acalog-degrees before you register.
- COURSE PLACEMENT:** If the proper prerequisites for any MATH/STAT course have not been satisfied, students MUST take the Math Placement Test. All placement test scores MUST be less than 2 years old (from the date the test was taken). Visit at.csn.edu/math-placement for more information about the Math Placement Test. **NOTE: No placement or other test is needed for entry into MATH 95E, 104B, 116, or 120E (w/ corequisite MATH 20).**
- STRETCH COURSES:** MATH 120E with corequisite MATH 20, MATH 124E with corequisite MATH 24, and MATH 126E with corequisite 26 are all **5 credit stretch courses** (3 credits for the college level or MATH 12xE component and 2 credits for the remedial or MATH 2x component; the 'x' is in place of the 0, 4, or 6 depending on the course you need). Stretch courses transfer to other institutions the same as their "traditional" counterparts (MATH 120, MATH 124, and MATH 126). To successfully enroll into a stretch course, you must add the MATH 12xE course of your choosing AND the MATH 2x corequisite course with the same four-digit section number.

ALL PREREQUISITE COURSES MUST BE COMPLETED WITH A "C" OR BETTER.
