

# Phlebotomy Advisement Sheet

## Certificate of Completion (6 Credits)

Spring, Summer & Fall

The Clinical Lab Sciences Program will be responsible for managing the application process. An admission committee will be responsible for the selection of students. Applicants will be ranked and selected using a point system. Please see Selection Criteria Sheet.

**Qualified applicants must:**

- Have a High School diploma, High School transcripts, GED equivalent OR unofficial college/university transcripts with an AWARDED degree
- Have a minimum of English 101 or 113 and Math 95 on the Placement Exams OR have completed English 100 (or higher) and Math 95 or higher (includes Math 100B, 104B, 111B or 116)

**OR**

Placement into English 101 or 113 and Math 95 or higher

Note: Placement Exams must be completed no more than 5 years prior to the application deadline.

**ATTENTION:** A clinical practicum consisting of 120 hours of training at a specified clinical site is required for program completion. This rotation is typically completed within a 3-week period consisting of 8 hour days, Monday through Friday following the successful completion of CLS 151 and CLS 152.

**IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER:**

- Selection Occurs: Three times a year
- Program Begins: **Fall**                      **Spring**                      **Summer**
- Application Deadline: **July 1**                      **Oct. 1**                      **March 1**
- Applications Accepted: **May 1-July 1**      **Aug 1-Oct 1**      **Jan 1-March 1**

**Proof of completion of program requirements must be submitted to the department no later than the application deadline.**

- Maximum number of students admitted: Dependent upon space availability

**PROGRAM COURSES:** These are specialized courses within a health discipline and are restricted to students who have been accepted into the program. Program courses are subject to revision; this will not impact program admission.
