- **Have successfully completed military health care training: Basic Medical Technician Corpsman Program (Navy and Air Force), Air Force Independent Duty Medical Technician, or Army Health Care Specialist**
- **Submit official military transcript(s) to the Office of the Registrar**
- **Be honorably discharged within three (3) years of program application deadline date**
- **Have earned a high school diploma or equivalent (i.e., GED or HiSet)**
- **Have satisfied requirements for ENG 100, 101, 102, 110, 113, or 114 by CLEP, residence, or other approved transfer/challenge method**
