- II. Guests
 1. Dr. Klip
 - a. 65 Nominations for Strategic Connections taskforce.
 - i. If not selected, there are still opportunities to be involved to participate in sub-committees and taskforce.
 - b. BOR meeting March 5 and 6 on Charleston campus.
 - i. Terminology regarding Administrative Faculty and Academic faculty
 1. May be on the next BOR meeting agenda.
 - c. Thanked AFA and CSN community for sharing concerns about upcoming career fair and concerns with Customs and Border Patrol (CBP).
 - d. Many activities for Black History Month, including Frederick Douglas celebration at Horn Theater.
 2. Lisa Bakke
 - a. Received new enrollment numbers, and will review how the new enrollment numbers will impact
 - b. Approved fee increases will cover COLA. This will cover State and Access, not the entire funding formula.
 - c. If payment is not received a payment by Tuesday, January 27th, a run a non-payment list will be run, connected with Bibliu and the publishers, and students' access to course materials will be revoked.
 - d. Food Services
 - i. Not many changes from Fall to Spring.
 - ii. Open Monday through Thursday, 8am to 4pm.
 1. Grills open 10am to 2pm.
 2. Closed at all locations on Friday.
 - iii. Henderson Grill remains closed, Just Baked machines open for hot food options, and Starbucks remains opened.
 1. Turbo Food options being expanded.
 2. Henderson Grill had extremely low foot traffic, but could potentially open if demand increases.
 - iv. NLV Grill open, but Starbucks remains closed.
 - v. West Charleston Grill open, Starbucks open.
 1. Five-week cycle for grill offerings.
 2. West Charleston partnered with GrubHub.
 - e. Paw Pass launched as the official campus card.
 - i. Fall 2025 pilot with 700 users, which went extremely well.
 - ii. We are officially a mobile-first campus.

- iii. Campus-id cards are still available. Users can have one or the other (Paw Pass or campus-id card, but not both).
 - 1. Health Sciences/EMS students can have both, but have to provision their Paw Pass first.
- iv. Meghan's team will be in front of Student Government the first three weeks of the semester.
 - 1. The first two weeks at each campus, 10am – 2pm to assist students with provisioning.
 - 2. The third week Meghan's team will be at Connections to assist students with provisioning.
 - 3. Students can also self-serve off of CSN website.

3. Lisa Bakke, Vice President, Finance

- a. Upcoming BOR January 23.
 - i. Two fees: Distance Education Fees and Academic Success Fees will be discussed. (Supported by Students)
 - ii. Registration fee increase
 - 1. Two main options which vary in implementation.
 - a. 9 percent distributed across three years, 2 percent in FY 27, 3 percent FY 28, 4 percent in FY 29.
 - i. By FY 2029, CSN should have covered the 5.3 million for payroll.
 - b. No increase in FY 27, but a 5 percent increase in FY 28, and 4 percent in FY 29.
 - iii. Once fees are determined, EBOC will be looking at processes, and Lisa's area will be reprojecting revenue.
