ELIGIBILITY

- Nominations are open to all full and part-time Classified, Academic, and Administrative Faculty who have been employed at CSN for a minimum of three (3) years
- Nominees must demonstrate innovative practices inside and/or outside the classroom, exemplify strong leadership, and foster a culture of excellence, professional growth, and inspiration among their colleagues
- For consideration, this nomination material must be answered in completion and typed

SELECTION PROCESS

The IRC will review nominations and submit their recommendations to the Office of the President for final selections. Travelling to accept this award is not required. The College will ensure that the award and certificate are sent to any recipient who cannot travel to the NISOD International Conference. Travel is contingent on college funding.
