Jumpstart Concurrent Enrollment Courses Approved for Concurrent Enrollment and Instructor Qualifications

The qualifications to teach concurrent enrollment courses vary by academic department. The preferred qualification is a master's degree in the field. When the master's degree is not in the respective field, **18** graduate credits in the respective field is required.

| MATH 095 | Elementary Algebra (3 credits) | Master of Mathematics or Statistics. Or a Bachelor in Mathematics and a Master in another discipline, plus 18 graduate level credits in Mathematics. |
| MATH 096 | Intermediate Algebra (3 credits) | Master of Mathematics or Statistics. Or Bachelor of Mathematics and a Master in another discipline, plus 18 graduate level credits in Mathematics. |

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| MATH 120 | Fundamentals of College Mathematics (3 credits) | Master of Mathematics or Statistics. Or Bachelor of Mathematics and a Master in another discipline, plus 18 graduate level credits in Mathematics. |
| MATH 126 | Precalculus I (3 credits) | Master of Mathematics or Statistics; Or a Bachelor of Mathematics and a Master in another discipline, plus 18 graduate level credits in Mathematics. |
| MATH 127 | Precalculus II (3 credits) | Master of Mathematics or Statistics; Or a Bachelor of Mathematics and a Master in another discipline, plus 18 graduate level credits in Mathematics. |
