TIMELY WARNING: MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT

INCIDENT DETAILS:

On 03/01/2018 at 9:08 A.M. a victim parked their 1993 Honda Civic in the parking lot West of "L" Building at the West Charleston Campus. At 12:58 P.M. A black sedan drove behind the Honda Civic and stopped. At that time, a un identifiable suspect exited the black sedan, entered the victims unoccupied Honda Civic, and drove the Civic away without permission of the owner. INCIDENT DETAILS:

On 03/08/2018 at about 7:30 A.M. a victim parked their blue 1998 Honda Civic in the East parking lot at the West Charleston Campus. At 8:42 A.M. A green Honda Civic entered the East parking lot and a white male suspect exited the green Honda Civic. The White male entered the victims unoccupied 1998 Honda Civic and within one-minute drove away in the victim's vehicle without the owner's consent. The victim's vehicle followed the suspect vehicle out of the Northeast exit towards Community College Drive and Charleston. The CSN Police Department is also investigating this crime.
